### First Aid Measures

General information In all cases of doubt, or if symptoms persist, seek medical attention. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Inhalation Move affected person to fresh air and keep warm and at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues. Ingestion Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Give plenty of water to drink Give milk instead of water if readily available Do not induce vomiting Get medical attention if any discomfort continues Skin contact Wipe off excess material with cloth or paper Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water Get medical attention if any discomfort continues Eye contact Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Remove any contact lenses and open eyelids wide apart. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.

### Spillage Procedure

Personal precautions In case of spills, beware of slippery floors and surfaces. Wear appropriate protective clothing. Environmental precautions Do not discharge into drains or watercourses or onto the ground. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up Methods for cleaning up Absorb in vermiculite, dry sand or earth and place into containers

### Handling and Storage

Store in tightly-closed, original container in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place


### Disposal Considerations

Dispose of waste to licensed waste disposal site in accordance with the requirements of the local Waste Disposal Authority.

### Fire Prevention

Suitable extinguishing media Water spray, fog or mist. Foam, carbon dioxide or dry powder. Unsuitable extinguishing media Do not use water jet as an extinguisher, as this will spread the fire.
